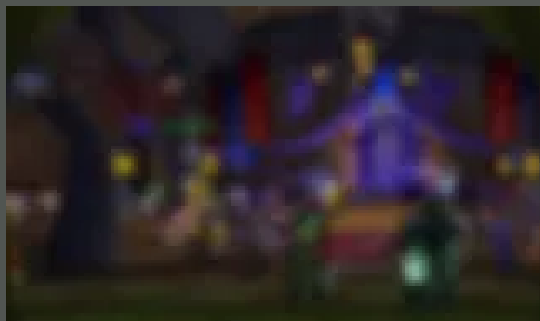
It was time for some humor! From Ms. D'Argentine to many amongst the Tribes it has been a hellacious week and a half since storming the portal and a remedy was needed!

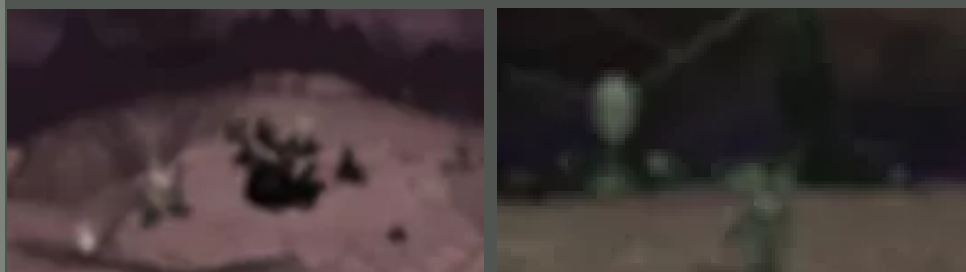
## Tribes' Chieftain Grievously Injured

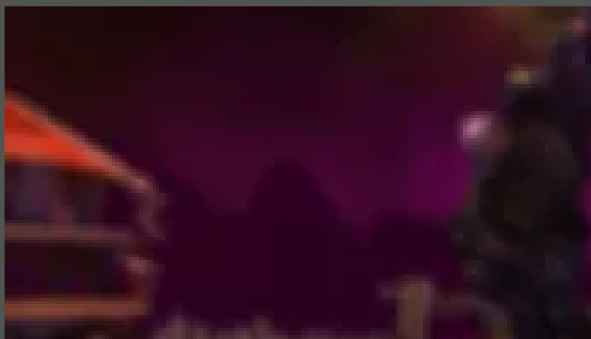
Blacktooth Grin seeking to take advantage of the new Gom Kuu'Jak Pact attempt to enter Thrallmar with peaceful intentions.

*We are in a foreign land.*

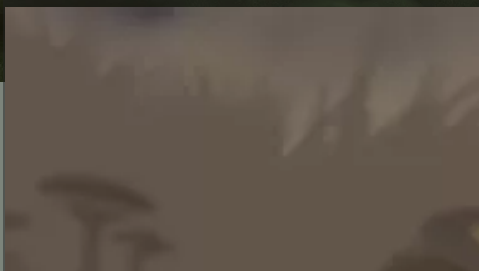
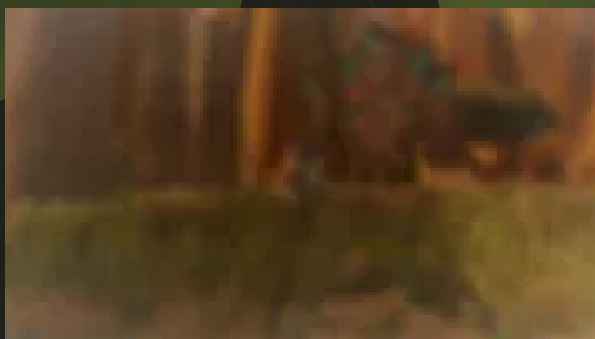

*But with that comes worry... worry for those that went to the front lines, but also some curiosity, perhaps?*

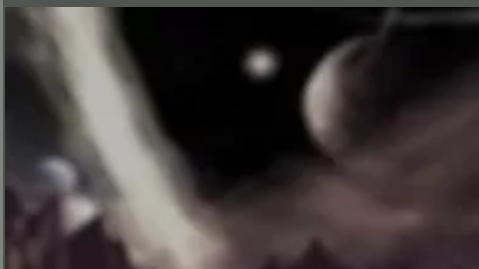
*The solution?*

*He is still finding words to try to convey what this landscape is like and what war the Horde is now embroiled in or the disagreements between Aldor and Scryer...*



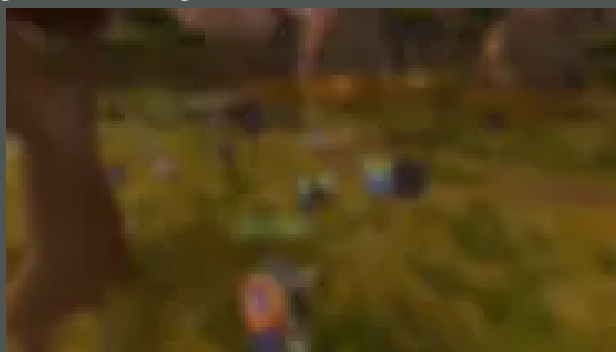

*The Shu'halo in Garadar, but what or who are they watching?*

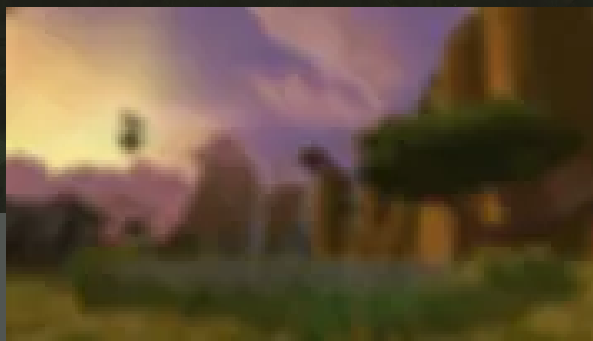

Unless you've paid someone to throw your javelin-esqe body through my head like a bullet, I'd settle down before you get pummeled.

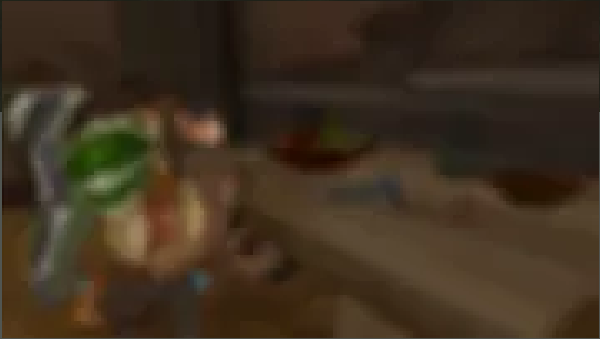
